

Six Grade Supply List 2018-2019

The list below includes materials needed by our incoming Sixth grade students. Please plan to purchase these items *before* the beginning of the 2018-2019 academic year. Not listed are a dictionary and thesaurus, which you may already have at home for personal use. If you do not possess a dictionary and thesaurus, then please purchase one (your students will be using them at home). Please note that the listed materials are a minimum; additional supplies may be requested by a particular teacher.

General items that will be collected by 1st period teacher:

Two pink pearl erasers
One small pencil sharpener to be kept in pencil pouch
Three or more **Expo Brand** Markers (whiteboard markers) odorless
One Ruler with inches and centimeters (labeled with first and last name)
One, 2 inch, 3 ring binder (**McClure only**)
Five Dividers (**McClure only**)
Box of skinny Crayola Markers (**Schwalenberg only**)

6th Grade Science:

At the start of the academic school year Math and Science teachers will organize and label sections with their classes. Students may arrive on the first day with the supplies; **notebooks do not need to be put together at home**. These 3-ring binders will be used AND KEPT in class, so not to weigh down backpacks. Students may need new spiral notebooks throughout the year as theirs fill up.
