## Principal Katy Clark Report

- Thank you for coming and participating in this meeting in person. We appreciate seeing you.
- We want to find opportunities to have families on campus and have everyone see the staff working hard and we are working on more events and opportunities.
- Please read the Medogram - addresses the issue of chronic absenteeism: 25% or more missing 20% or more of the school year. Every 15 minutes starts adding up - picking up early or arriving late.
- Support staff is here for your students if they have anxiety about coming to school we want to support them. 180 school days approx
- Check grade level websites and help support students at home.
- Second round of national MAP test at the very end of November 30th and 1st of December. Math and Reading comprehension. School action plan is based on the data and progress monitoring.
