Dear Meadows Families,

I hope everyone enjoyed the time spent with family and friends over Thanksgiving break. It's hard to believe that December is upon us and 2021 is coming to a close.

When I sat down to write this month's Med-o-gram message, I encountered a little writer's block. In trying to stir up some creativity, I did a little research and re-read some of my past words, and I keep coming back to two different messages.

One I wrote way back in July of 2020 when I first introduced myself to our Meadows community:

*Not only am I excited to begin working with your children, but I look forward to the work we will do together. As the old African proverb says, "It takes a village to raise a child." Parents, staff, and students all have different and important perspectives that we will use to work together to ensure that we offer the best middle school experience possible.*

And the second message I just wrote this September about the importance of community:

*One definition of community is "a body of people who live in the same place," but initially it meant something much simpler and more powerful: "joint ownership." I really love that simple definition because that is what we are aiming for here at Meadows. All staff members, all parents and guardians and all students should have joint ownership within our community. And when we demonstrate joint ownership, school culture turns more positive.*

I re-read these two snippets and was reminded that we have a shared responsibility to educate the whole child. Parents cannot do this without communication and guidance from the school. Teachers cannot do this without the support and reinforcement parents provide at home. Students cannot learn without clear expectations and boundaries at both home and school. But we can educate the whole child when we share the responsibility. This is not a new concept but is becoming increasingly more necessary as we face new hurdles and challenges.

I strongly believe in the work we are doing here at Meadows and know that we are always on the path towards continuous improvement. Thank you for partnering with us in that endeavor. I am forever grateful that I have the responsibility of leading Madison Meadows and I hope you know how much I appreciate every staff member, parent, and student for what they bring to our community.

The next few weeks will probably pass in a blur. I hope you find time to slow down, connect with others and have meaningful conversations, and prioritize and make time for what is most important.

# From the Attendance Office

## Attendance Do's and Don'ts:

### **DO - Arrive on time**

It is very important for children to develop the habit of being punctual at an early age. Being consistently on time helps your student learn about routines and commitment. It also gives them the opportunity to greet their friends before class and this can reduce the possibility of disruptions in the classroom. Entering a classroom late can make your child feel uncomfortable and can upset other children.

### **DON'T - Arrive late with Starbucks**

If you have time for the drive-thru, you have time to bring your child to school on-time. This year, the cafeteria is offering free breakfast for all students so your student can eat healthy even if you aren't able to feed them at home.

### **DO - Report your student's absence before 9:30 AM**

The best time to contact attendance is the moment you decide not to send your child to school. Call (602) 664-7620 or email [meadowsattendance@madisoned.org](mailto:meadowsattendance@madisoned.org)

**DON'T - Worry if you called in an excuse for your student, but they were marked absent** in 1st period. Teachers will mark your student absent and then the attendance clerk updates excuses. Sometimes the office is very busy in the morning and it can take longer to get through messages.

### **DO - Send your student to school even if** they are sad, depressed, or anxious.

Sometimes these feelings can stem from missed schoolwork (even if they don't want to admit it) and continued absences will only make this worse. If you are worried about your student, have them reach out to their grade-level counselor, school psychologist, or stop into the office to talk. There are so many adults at school that are ready to support your child. Learn more about "School Refusal"

**DON'T - Send your student to school if** they have had a fever or have been throwing up within the past 24 hours, complain of bad pain, or have trouble breathing.

### **DON'T - Bring** your student take-out food for lunch.
