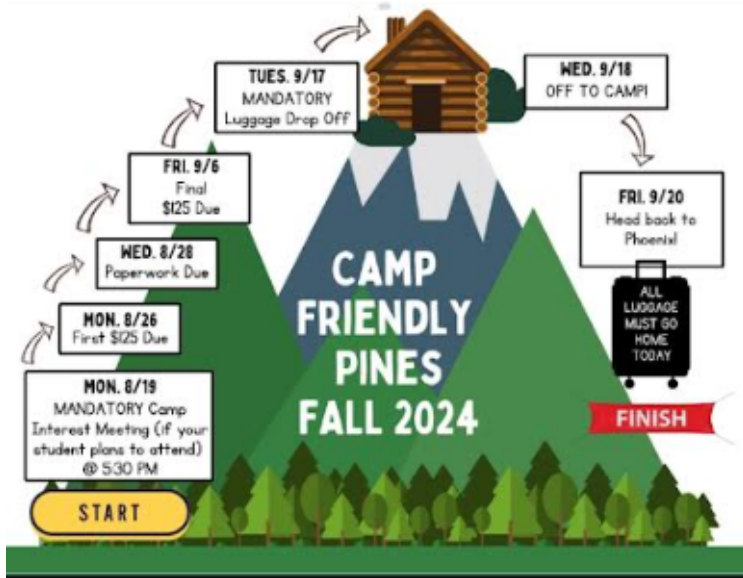

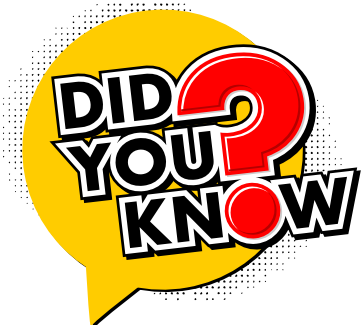

Q: Are you married?

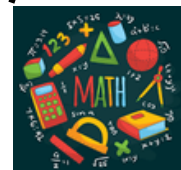
A: No.

A: Lewis-Clark State College in Lewiston, Idaho

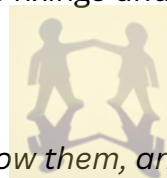


Q: Do you have any hidden talents?
